## Want To Go To Kampala, Uganda?

### Why Go?

Because the great commission includes Kampala, Uganda. The Lord sends us.

Because the need is great. Kampala has almost 3,000,000 people, many of whom experience extreme poverty, are affected by AIDS, live in spiritual darkness and have little hope. They need the hope found in the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to experience the love of Jesus that lives in you.

Because the Lord's harvest field in Kampala is white and ready for harvest. Many are ready to hear and receive the gospel, and many are. The door is wide open.

Because we can. God has given us the wealth and time to go. The question is not can we – but will we?

Because our brothers and sisters in Christ need us. They have a huge job and few resources; they pray for us to come.

### *Apathy – The Inactive level*

These churches know the great commission, but do nothing about it. Their interest doesn't go beyond their front door.

### *Aware – The Interested level*

These churches are acting on the great commission by giving to mission work, praying for missions and studying mission activity.

### *Active – The Involved level*

These churches not only give, pray and study, they go on mission trips. They are actively involved in expanding the kingdom as they send teams all over the world on short-term trips.

### *Advocate – The Invested level*

These churches do more than give, pray, study and go; they sense the call of God to a place and join Him there. This place becomes a part of their church field. They invest themselves and enlist the help of others. Their commitment is not for a week or two, but they are committed to stay till the job is done. Will you become an advocate of Kampala?



## Typical Schedule (16 Days)

Leave Atlanta on Friday afternoon and arrive in Kampala Saturday night (on KLM).

Sunday, we attend one of the Kampala Christian Church Network's celebration services and have orientation with John Barnett, City Strategist for the IMB and head of the Kampala Urban Team.

Monday through Saturday is given to street evangelism, church planting, attending house church services and showing the Jesus film. The daily schedule will look something like this (remember it is subject to change):

7:30 - 8:30 Breakfast

8:30 - 9:00 Devotion

9:30-12:00 Evangelism & House Church

12:00 - 2:00 Lunch

2:00 - 6:00 Evangelism & House Church

7:00 - 9:00 Dinner

Second Sunday, attend KCCN celebration service and pack for game park.

Monday through Wednesday, game park and R&R.

Thursday, meet with Kampala IMFC Staff at the Ministry Center, attend house church meeting, shop and pack to go home.

Friday, attend Manna Food Distribution and head home.

Arrive back in Atlanta on Saturday afternoon.

## Approximate Cost

### Additional Out-of-Pocket Expense

The major cost factor is "When" you go. Summer will be the most expensive time, but if you must go in the Summer, leave before July 15.

## What Will You Do?

*Prayer walk neighborhoods.* You will be praying against the spiritual strongholds that lock the people in darkness.

*Give personal testimony.* Be prepared to share with individuals and in worship services what God has done in your life. They love to hear your story.

*Deliver Bible lessons or sermons.* Some of you will be asked to preach. Many laymen preach their first sermon here. Ladies, you may be asked to lead a Bible study for women. Don't be surprised.

*Love the people of Kampala.* They will love you and you will have the opportunity to return that love. You will make life-long friends.

*Assist our IMB missionaries, learn their heart, and fall in love with them.*
